FOOD CHAIN POSTER GUIDELINES

Your goal is to make a poster and write a report about food chain.

What to do?

Research a desert food chain and an ocean food chain.

Find answers to the following questions:

- How are all the food chains alike?
- What kinds of food chain are in the ocean?
- What kinds are in land?
- What is the source of energy for all food chains?
- What might happen if one part of a food chain disappeared?

You can use different sources to find information about food chains. Sources include books, magazines, and internet.

Find and cut out pictures of different animals and plants. Arrange your pictures to make **a model of 2 food chains**. (poster 28 x 22). Write the name of the animal beneath, and what he eats. A sample of what poster will look like is giving.

Report must be hand-written, questions are to be written and answers must be in complete sentences. First, write questions. Then, skip a line and write the answers on the next line. Information must be in your own words. Remember to check for spelling and punctuation. Report must be clean and neatly presented on the center of the poster.
